Post Officers and Committee Reports: The following reports were given:

- <u>Membership</u> As of July 9, 2013 Post 110's 2013 membership is at 368 which is 92.70% of its goal of 397 members. The membership drive for 2014 has started and the Post Adjutant has 2014 membership cards for those renewing their membership. As memberships are renewed, the Post Adjutant will submit required paperwork to 2nd District, Virginia Department and National Headquarters.
- **<u>Finance</u>** Finance Officer gave his report.
- <u>Awards</u> Commander reported that Chaplain George Schmidt was selected as American Legion Post 110's "2012-2013 Legionnaire of the Year". Membership concurred with his selection. Schmidt's name was submitted to Virginia Department in Richmond, VA for awarding of appropriate pin.
- <u>Webmaster</u> Craig Huber reported that updating of Post's website is continuing. All past years meeting minutes have been backed on CD and will be deleted from the website. Only the current legion year minutes will be shown on the website in the future. Post 110's website is at <u>www.vapost110.org</u>.
- <u>Face book</u> Historian Brain Abbott reported that the Post's face book page will be updated and kept current. Post 110's face book page is at <u>www.facebook.com</u>.
- <u>Red Cross Blood Drive</u> Vice Commander Dan Ryan reported that he is working with the Red Cross to set up a date of Saturday July 27, 2013, 10am-3pm, at the Virginia Beach Blood Donation Center at Pembroke Mall. - <u>Post Chaplain</u>: Chaplin Schmidt reports that he has been assisting a veteran with transportation to the VA Hospital in Hampton, VA and finalizing his enrollment for VA benefits. The Chaplain has also helped with writing the veteran's resume and submitting both online and direct job applications.

Long Range Goals:

Look into finding a location/building in Virginia Beach, VA to be a permanent home for American Legion Post 110. Commander Wendell plans to meet and discuss, at some future date, with other American Legion Post Commanders in this area to see if a joint venture can be realized.

Short Range Goals: None at this time.

Old Business:

• Post Adjutant Doug Uhlmann has filed the 2012-2013 Post 110's Consolidated Report with the Virginia Department. He has also filed Form 990-N (Tax-Exempt Organizations not Required To File Form 990 or 990-EZ) Form with the IRS for 2012.

- Post Service Officer Doug Uhlmann has been contacted recently by several veterans for Temporary Financial Assistance (TFA). Paperwork was submitted to VA Department to get these veterans funding to help them during their hardships.
- At June 12, 2013 meeting, a motion was made and seconded that Post 110 reimburse Service Officer Doug Uhlmann for his registration and hotel cost of \$272.92 while attending the 2013 American Legion Leadership College being held August 9-10, 2013 in Richmond, VA. Membership voted its approval based on availability of funds in the treasury. Finance Officer, who was absent from the meeting, was contacted later and he said, that funds will be available in the near future to reimburse him.

New Business:

- Commander Wendell asked all American Legion Post 110 members to become more active in the recruitment of new members and the encouragement of existing members to renew their membership. Membership applications were made available to all attending the meeting to start the 2014 membership drive.
- This item was not mentioned until after the meeting was adjourned, however, it is of importance that it be brought up at this time and will be part of the next meeting's agenda. Service Officer Doug Uhlmann recommended that Post 110 purchase the following two publications that would be useful to him in performing his duties: "Federal Veterans Laws, Rules and Regulations" (\$63.00) and "Veterans Benefits Manual" (\$146.00).

Correspondence Received by American Legion Post 110:

- Letter and Application/Renewal Form 2013-2014 was received from the "Hampton Roads Council of Veterans Organizations". Post 110 will renew its membership in this organization as soon as additional funds become available. Post 110 will provide volunteer marchers in the HRCVO sponsored Tidewater Veterans Day Parade in Virginia Beach, VA on Monday, 11 November 2013.
- Letter from "Wreaths Across America" was received asking for a donation to support the placement of wreaths on the graves of veterans across the country and at 24 overseas locations. Post 110 will support this project when funds become available.
- Invitation to participate in the "Rock to Rescue" which is sponsored by the American Humane Association's Red Star Rescue program and will be held at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Senior Care Center during the month of September 2013. Donations needed to support in the rescue of stranded and mistreated animals. Some dogs are trained to assist disabled seniors and military veterans. Post 110 will support this project based on the availability of funds.

Good of the Legion: 2nd District Commander Mike Bukowski and District Adjutant Al Steward both asked that all Post 110 members be active in the 2014 membership drive. Post Commander and Vice Commander will continue calling, emailing and writing letters to membership to encourage meeting attendance and membership renewal. No further recommendations or suggestions at that time.
