<u>Call to Order:</u> The May 14, 2014 meeting of American Legion Post 110 was called to order at 1930 by presiding Commander Bert Wendell, Jr.

<u>Introduction of Guest, Prospective and New Members:</u> Steve Sokolowski introduced the Boy's State Delegates for 2014 from Bishop Sullivan High School: Timothy J. Keating, Charles S Pitchford, and Kyle E. Phillips. Upon completion of Boy's State in June (15-21) at Radford University, the delegates are invited to attend the Post's meeting on July 9, 2014 to comment on their experiences and receive their medals and certificates.

<u>Officer's Roll Call:</u> A roll call of Post 110's Officers was conducted and having a quorum Post business was discussed and voted on.

Reading of Minutes: The April 9, 2014 meeting minutes was not read due to time constraints.

<u>Guest Speaker/Special Recognition:</u> Guest speaker was Brian Abbott, Post Historian and a member of the SS United State Conservancy, spoke on the restoration and curatorial development aboard the historic ocean liner SS United States. The almost 1,000-feet long ocean liner started its maiden voyage on July 3, 1952 and set a speed record of 35.59 knots or more than 44 miles per hour. This record still stands today. The ship is moored in Philadelphia, PA and awaits restoration to become a floating museum.



Major Topics Discussed:

* Received an email from Cathy Hoy, Bayside Library, 936 Independence Blvd, Virginia Beach, VA. She requested that Post 110 conduct an American Flag Class on Tuesday,

June 24, 2014 from 2-4 PM. The audience will be adults and some senior citizens. Adjutant reports that 55 worn U.S. Flags have been properly disposed of to-date.



<u>Service Officer:</u> There was <u>one</u> request by a veteran for assistance in obtaining Temporary Financial Assistance (TFA). After investigation the veteran was determined to not eligible.

Finance: Finance Officer Steve Sokolowski presented a to-date budget report show in that the Post is in good standing. A discussion was had and approval was given to order the following items:

Pitchford, and Kyle E. Phillips. Delegates will learn about local, state and federal government. Also, they will develop civic leadership skills and pride in American Citizenship.
