The class will include a short history of the American Flag; how to display the Flag; proper handling of the Flag; and how to fold the Flag. - * It was discussed that American Legion Post 110 contribute \$1,000.00 to a graduating senior from a Virginia Beach, VA high school in 2015 under the American Legion ROTC/NJROTC Scholarship Program. This is all based on the availability of funds next year.
- * The American Legion Paid Up For Life Membership (PUFL) was discussed. PUFL is a membership you purchase with a lump sum or 36 equal monthly payments that makes you a PUFL Member of the American Legion. An application, Form 32-001(2011), must be filled out by you; endorsed by Post 110's Adjutant or Finance Officer; then forwarded to Virginia Department for their endorsement; and they send it to National Headquarters for approval. - * April 23, 2014 letter from Congressman Scott Rigell's Office asks that American Legion Post 110 participate in the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam War. The ceremony will be held on July 1, 2014, 4-7 PM, at the Virginia Beach Convention Center. Post 110 will be represented at the ceremony. <u>Committee Reports:</u> The following committee reports were given:

Elections: An installation ceremony of Post 110's 2014-2015 Officers was conducted on June 11, 2014.

<u>Adjutant:</u> Doug Uhlmann was not present at the meeting. However, he still needs to receive from each Post member, by the first week of each month, the volunteer hours and miles driven in support of American Legion business and volunteer activities. He reports that the 2013-2014 Post Consolidated Report was forwarded to the Virginia Department with a copy to the 2^{nd} District.

<u>Membership</u>: 2014 membership, as of June 4, 2014, is 342 with a current year goal of 369 for a 92.683% of goal. 26 renewals or new members are required to be at 100% of goal. The Post will continually strive to increase membership through active participation and planned events. <u>Note</u>: 2015 membership drive is starting and membership cards are available from the Post Adjutant, once the \$35.00 dues are paid. The Paid Up For Life (PUFL) Program was discussed.

<u>Service Officer</u>: Doug Uhlmann was not present at the meeting. No request for Temporary Financial Assistance (TFA).

<u>Finance</u>: Finance Officer Steve Sokolowski presented a 2014 to-date budget report showing that the Post is in good standing. Post 110's 2015 Budget Plan has been proposed. After a review and discussion at the July 9, 2014 Post meeting, an approval vote by the membership will be called for by the Post Commander.

<u>American Legion Boy's State of Virginia:</u> Wendell Parker, Post 110's committee chairman for Boy's State, reports that 2014 Boy's State will be held June 15-21, 2014 at Radford University in Radford, VA. Post 110 is sponsoring three delegates: 3- from Bishop Sullivan Catholic High School. Cost to sponsor three delegates is \$1,500 which

includes transportation (contracted bus) fee and the registration fee. Names of the delegates are Timothy J. Keating, Charles S. Pitchford, and Kyle E. Phillips. Delegates will learn about local, state and federal government. Also, they will develop civic leadership skills and pride in American Citizenship. The delegates will receive medals and certificates at the July 9, 2014 Post meeting.

- Commander Wendell asked all American Legion Post 110 members to become more active in the recruitment of new members and the encouragement of existing members to renew their membership. Membership applications were made available to all attending.

- Invite other Virginia Beach Post Commanders to attend one of Post 110's monthly meetings or a separate meeting to discuss how we can interact and possibly come together to obtain a permanent American Legion Home in Virginia Beach, VA.
