Adjutant Rick Jones: So far we have had 216 renewals vs our 2019 goal of 347 members. The post has met the August, Sept and October milestone targets for membership. Rick was approached by a veteran who needs help with painting his home. He will investigate details and discuss action plan for a paint party at the next Executive Board Meeting. Also, the post received a \$100 dollar donation from Mrs. Paige Brage in the memory of her Uncle Mr. David A. Fernandes.

Finance Officer Steve Sokolowski: Financial status previous month: \$17,769 in Building Fund and \$2,466 in Post Checking account. 2019 budget was reviewed and approved by the membership. Post financial audit was completed in August.

Chaplain George Schmidt: Absent.

Sqt. At Arms Jeff Kocab: Absent.

Web Master Craig Huber: Absent. Website is up to date.

Vice Commander/Historian Bert Wendell: Absent. Reported that \$288 was raised at the Oceana NAS airshow last month. Also received seven leads for new members.

Commander Fred Kinkin: Stressed the importance of finding new members. Volunteer activity September ytd: 655 hours and 3,655 miles. Veteran's Day parade this year will be Monday, November 12th; we will also have a Veteran's Day commemoration at OLPH on Friday, November 9th.

Guest Speaker/Special Recognition:

Willard Smith, Director of Vet's House described the operations of Vet's House which assists homeless veterans get back in the workforce and provides housing for up to 26 veterans for up to one year. The post presented a check for \$100 to Willard Smith to help fund operations. All veterans are invited to a cookout at 200 N. Oceana Blvd on Nov 11th from 1130 – 1600.
