<u>Call to Order:</u> The August 2020 meeting of American Legion Post 110 was called to order by Commander, Rick Jones.

<u>Officer's Roll Call:</u> A roll call of Post 110's Officers was conducted, and having a quorum, business was discussed. 12 members were present.

Committee Reports:

- Service Officer: Eric Bell. Absent
- Adjutant Fred Kinkin: Current paid membership is 175 vs goal of 328 (53%). The post received 5 milestone awards for meeting membership milestone targets last year. 2020 final volunteer hours were 2,218 and 10,181 miles driven. July volunteer hours were 41 with 155 miles driven. All were reminded to continue to report their volunteer hours to the Adjutant.
- Finance Officer Jon Asher: Financial status was: \$18,665 in building fund savings account; \$3,451 in Post Checking account. The post is in the process of consolidating both accounts into NFCU.

- 1. 2nd District VCDR, Membership provided an overview of the state of membership for the American Legion nationally, at the State level and for the District and Post. He challenged members to find new members since overall membership at the national level has dropped by 9% over the past four years. He also discussed the use of technology to better manage American Legion affairs and reviewed the plan to convert to eProcessing for renewals. The Post received four new transfers from Post 141 as a result of the DMS Engagement the past weekend. Another engagement will be conducted in October.
- 2. A new member incentive of \$20 dues reduction the first year was proposed and approved by unanimous vote.
