<u>Call to Order</u>: The July meeting of American Legion Post 110 was called to order by Commander, Ron Basso.

<u>Officer's Roll Call:</u> A roll call of Post 110's Officers was conducted, and having a quorum, business was discussed. 13 members were present.

- Service Officer: Eric Bell. Absent
- Adjutant Fred Kinkin: Current paid membership renewals for 2024 is 103. The post received 4 milestone awards for meeting membership milestone targets last year. 2020 final volunteer hours were 1,438 and 4,673 miles driven. All were reminded to continue to report their volunteer hours to the Adjutant. Final 2023 membership was 288 for the Post. The post will not have a membership table at a Tides game this year because the Tides are charging \$500 to reserve a table.

Commander Ron Basso recognized Rick Jones, Past Post Commander for his 3 years of dedicated service as Post Commander. He presented Rick with a "Past Commander" hat pin.

It was noted that the Post received 2nd Place in the Department of Virginia post history notebook contest. Historian Bert Wendell will be recognized for the effort at the Department Fall Conference in Williamsburg this October.

The two Boys State candidates that represented the post at the June Boys State program spoke about their experiences; one of the three Jr. Law Enforcement Program candidates' mother also spoke about her daughter's experience there. The Boys State attendees were awarded certificates of participation for the program.

Historian Bert Wendell introduced the Melberg family who spoke about their grandfather, Robert C. Melberg, our post namesake. Robert's daughter Mia presented a contribution check to the post in the amount of \$1,110.

The post must provide its own table and chairs; there is no charge for the place. At the August post meeting we will finalize the watch bill for the event. We will have four 4 hour slots to man the table and will need at least two members in each time slot.
