<u>Call to Order:</u> The August 23, 2023 meeting of American Legion Post 110 was called to order by Commander, Ron Basso.

<u>Officer's Roll Call:</u> A roll call of Post 110's Officers was conducted, and having a quorum, business was discussed. 7 members were present.

- Service Officer: Eric Bell. Absent
- Adjutant Fred Kinkin: Current paid membership renewals for 2024 is 163 vs target of 297 (55%). The post received 4 milestone awards for meeting membership milestone targets last year. July volunteer hours were 113 and miles driven was 1076.
- Finance Officer Bob Russell: Financial status was: \$4,696 in building fund savings account; \$15,334 in building fund CD and \$2,988 in Post Checking account.

Guest Speaker/Special Recognition:

One of the three Jr. Law Enforcement Camp candidates, Aiden Cartwright spoke about his experience there and his mother, Veronica gave her perspective on his attendance.

Major Topics Discussed

- 1. Fred Kinkin reported that the post had reserved a place in the large tent at the upcoming NAS Oceana airshow scheduled for September 16, 17. The post must provide its own table and chairs; there is no charge for the place. A watch bill for the event was discussed and had four volunteers; we still need to fill slots on Saturday afternoon and both Sunday morning and afternoon. Commander Basso will provide the truck for setup and removal of the table/chairs.
- 2. A new member incentive of \$30 dues for new members will be in effect until the end of December. This is a \$10 reduction of normal annual dues. Thus far we have two new members this year.
- 3. The budget for 2023-2024 was discussed and unanimously approved. Dave Smith made the motion for approval and Fred Kinkin seconded. Total expenditures of \$5,933 for the year are planned.
- 4. The Post will participate in a Veterans Day celebration at OLPH on Friday, November 10th at 10am. Post 113 will also be invited to attend.
- 5. Fred Kinkin summarized current legislation being drawn up in Congress regarding VA Community Care standards and improvements to the VA Accountability Act of 2017
- 6. The results of the table at National Night Out at Fort Story were one new member and five others who are interested but not yet joined.
